



## ***21 Scriptures about God's Love:***

1. **Zephaniah 3:17 (NLT)**  
For the LORD your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears. He will rejoice over you with joyful songs.”
2. **Romans 8:38-39 (CEB)**  
<sup>38</sup> I’m convinced that nothing can separate us from God’s love in Christ Jesus our Lord: not death or life, not angels or rulers, not present things or future things, not powers <sup>39</sup> or height or depth, or any other thing that is created.
3. **1 John 4:10 (NIV)**  
This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.
4. **Isaiah 54:10 (NIV)**  
Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed,” says the Lord, who has compassion on you.
5. **Psalms 89:2 (NIV)**  
I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you have established your faithfulness in heaven itself.
6. **1 John 4:19 (NIV)**  
We love because He first loved us.
7. **Titus 3:4-5a (NLT)**  
<sup>4</sup>When God our Savior revealed His kindness and love, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy.
8. **Psalms 136:1 (NIV)**  
Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good. His love endures forever.
9. **Lamentations 3:22-23 (NIV)**  
<sup>22</sup> Because of the Lord’s great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. <sup>23</sup> They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.
10. **John 15:9 (NIV)**  
“As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.



**11. Psalm 86:15 (NIV)**

But you, Lord, are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness.

**12. 2 Corinthians 5:13-14 (NIV)**

<sup>13</sup> If we are “out of our mind,” as some say, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. <sup>14</sup> For Christ’s love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

**13. Psalm 130:3-4 (TPT)**

<sup>3</sup> Lord, if you measured us and marked us with our sins, who would ever have their prayers answered? <sup>4</sup> But your forgiving love is what makes you so wonderful. No wonder you are loved and worshiped!

**14. John 14:21 (NIV)**

“Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them.”

**15. 1 John 4:16 (NIV)**

And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them.

**16. Romans 5:8 (NIV)**

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**17. Psalm 36:5 (NIV)**

Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens, Your faithfulness to the skies.

**18. 1 John 3:1a (NIV)**

See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!

**19. 1 John 4:12 (NIV)**

No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us.

**20. Ephesians 2:4-5 (NIV)**

<sup>4</sup> But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, <sup>5</sup> made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions - it is by grace you have been saved.

**21. 1 John 4:9 (NIV)**

This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.
