

GO NEXT! (Part II)

(Acts 2:37-47)

- 1. As **Go Church** travels on this journey, like any other traveler, we have to **pay** attention to certain indicators that will always assure us that we are on the right track. Sometimes, the most stressful part of a journey, aside from the inability to determine the destination, is a lack of assurance of the correct direction.
- 2. These indicators are called signposts, they give directions and make the trip a little less stressful. **The journey is just as important as the destination**. The experiences of the journey and how we handle the indicators will determine how well we do when we arrive at our destination.
- 3. The **first signpost** for the journey we are on reads: "*Everyone is welcome!*" (1 Cor. 9:19-23).

- C. We are all responsible to make the community a welcoming environment (1 Cor. 9:19-23)
