## Jesus, the Lamb of God

### Without Blemish

- Jn.1:29, 35-36
- 1 Pe.1:19
- Ex.12:5
- Lk.23:4; Jn.18:38; 19:4,6 - Jesus was declared without blemish 5 times.
- Mk.8:31 - He prepares His disciples for his death and resurrection (Lk.18:31-33).
- Rev.5:5-6 - you must behold the Lamb first before you can see the Lion of the tribe of Judah.

### Resurrection

- *Resurrection* proved Christ's divinity; secures victory over death for Christian believers' (Eph.2:4-6).
  - Purpose of the *resurrection*? Most associate it with eternal life, not with daily life on earth.
  - How is the *resurrection* significant in our marriages, our jobs, our families?
  - How does *resurrection* affect a life harried with errands, chores, obligations, demands?
1. Jesus is who He claimed to be; the promised **Savior of the world** (Jn.10:17-18 NIV).
  2. Our **sins are forgiven** (1 Co.15:17-23 TPT).
  3. We are instantly **adopted into God's family** (Jn.20:17; Ga.4:5; Eph.1:5; 3:14).
  4. We have **divine provisions & eternally secured** (Jn.21:1-3,11 (contrast w/Lk.5:4-6)). There's a difference between what was caught and what was kept (He lost none of those God gave Him even while they're threatened - Jn.18:8-9).
  5. The **disciples became bold** and no longer frightened or hiding away (Jn.20:1-10,19). Many in the church today live as if they've accepted defeat. Their thoughts are ruled by doubt rather than belief. They live with habitual patterns of sin. They keep their faith to themselves, thinking if they struggle so badly how could they possibly help someone else? This is what the Christian life looks like without resurrection power. That's what the disciples' lives looked like after the crucifixion. So, what was the first thing Jesus dealt with after the resurrection? He dealt with his follower's fear. Jesus walked through walls to meet them in their fears (He met them at their deepest point of need - Jn.20: 19,21,26).
  6. Jesus not only **freed the disciples from fear** but **equipped them with resurrection power** to be witnesses on the earth (Jn.20:21-23).
