GO NEXT! Part III

(Acts 2:42-47)

GO Church is traveling on a journey, paying close attention to certain indicators –**SIGNPOSTS**– to assure us that we are on the right track.

Quick Recap from last Sunday:

- **First Signpost: Everyone is welcome!**
 - *God wants everyone and so should you*
 - *Everyone means everyone, no fine prints*
 - *We are all responsible to make the Jesus community a welcoming place.*
- **Second Signpost: “Nobody is perfect, we are all growing”.**

When everyone, irrespective of background, is welcomed, we must be prepared to deal with a little bit of mess. But the good news is that God has that covered.

People come from different backgrounds, have different life experiences, have different exposures and different dispositions.

All these and other factors create our **ID + PUR = PA and PA + PO**
(*ID: identity; PUR: purpose; PA: predictable actions; PO: predictable outcomes*).

Examples:

- Jesus [Matt: 15:32]
- The early church [Acts 2:42-47]
- The Apostle Paul

Things to Note

In the Jesus community, everyone:

- Forbears one another in love (Eph. 4:1-3; 1 Peter 4:8-10).
- Is steadfastly committed to grow (Rom. 8:29-30; Acts 2:42; James 1:25).
- Is committed to accountability (Prov. 12:15; Phil.2:3-8).
